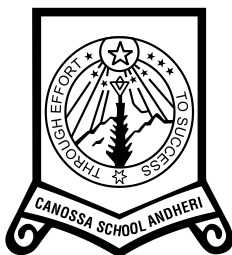

ST. MAGDALENE OF CANOSSA

Birth: 1st March, 1774 Death: 10th April, 1835



Foundress of the Canossian Daughters and Sons of Charity.

MAGDALENE GABRIELLE OF CANOSSA was born at Verona on 1st March, 1774. At the age of five, she lost her father. At seven, her mother remarried leaving all her five children in the Canossa Palace.

She was then entrusted to a governess who did not understand her and caused her to suffer much. She had just overcome this painful ordeal when she fell ill. Her long suffering brought her closer to God and Magdalene decided to consecrate herself wholly to Him.

Before knowing what was to be her mission in life, Magdalene tried the Cloistered life. The experiment convinced her that she was called to something else, so she returned home where she humbly and patiently awaited enlightenment from God. She dedicated herself to the care of her dear ones with great love, giving help, comfort and serenity to all those whom she encountered.

In 1797, when Napoleon's troops occupied Verona, Magdalene and her family sought refuge at Venice, where she experienced the difficulties and sadness of being in exile.

After returning to her native city, she was moved by the sight of the many miseries which were the lot of the poor. What impressed her most was the frightening state of so many children and ignorant young

girls, left to themselves and exposed to numerous dangers. Urged by ardent charity, she began to look out for them, assist and educate them and act as a mother to them. She was helped in this work by generous collaborators.

In 1808, free at last from all obligations to her family, she finally left her rich palace to live a poor life, and serve the poor in the parish of St. Zeno, the most destitute in the whole of Verona.

She thus gave life to the Institute of the Daughters of Charity, commonly known as 'Canossians' which was especially dedicated to catechesis, education of the neediest among poor girls, and to the assistance of the sick in public hospitals.

A few years later, the Institute came to Venice where Magdalene of Canossa would define its spirit and finalities, thence to Milan, Bergamo and Trent.

Ever since, the foundations have multiplied themselves. It is now **more than two hundred years**, since the Daughters of Charity realised the great dream-that of making Christ known to the extreme ends of the world. Today, the Sisters are found in all the continents, where they are committed to witness Christ in the exercise of all the works of mercy.

Magdalene of Canossa is also the foundress of the Sons of Charity, who share the same apostolic aim, as that of the Daughters of Charity.

She died on April 10th, 1835. Her typical virtues were, 'Humility in Charity' and 'Charity in Humility.'

She proposes Jesus Crucified and His Sorrowful Mother as models for imitation to all the members of her congregation.

On October 2nd 1988, Pope John Paul II declared her a SAINT.

ST. JOSEPHINE BAKHITA



BAKHITA was born in the region of SUDAN - AFRICA, in 1869.

As a little girl, this African flower, knew the anguish of slavery and kidnapping. She was stolen by slave-traders and cruelly tortured. In this traumatic experience, the little girl, could not remember her name and was re-named BAKHITA, which means 'The Lucky One'.

After being sold and resold in the markets of El-Obeid and Khartoum, she was finally bought by an Italian Consul. For the first time now, Bakhita experienced being loved and cared for, as a person. At her insistent request, she went with the Italian Consul, to Italy. She was then gifted to a couple that had a little daughter. Through them she came to know the Canossian Daughters of Charity in Venice.

She asked to be baptized as a Catholic. She then asked to offer herself totally to God, as a Canossian Sister. On 8th December 1896, she pronounced her First Vows of Poverty, Chastity and Obedience.

Simple, yet humble, she was full of love for God and neighbour. She was engaged in unassuming duties in the Canossian Convent. She was a portress, welcoming little girls and their mothers, who came to love this gentle, 'black sister'. She worked for sometime in the kitchen, serving her sisters with attention and love. She was excellent in embroidery and served as a Sacristan in the chapel.

On the 8th of February 1947, she breathed her last at the age of 78, in Schio-Italy. She was declared Blessed on 17th May, 1992, and publicly acknowledged a Saint in Rome on 1st October, 2000.

Bakhita is revered as a Saint, because she is a 'Universal Sister'. She became holy by doing every little thing with great love for God and for her neighbour. She was always cheerful and smiling, even when afflicted with arthritis. She never harboured thoughts of revenge or resentment against her captors. Infact, she prayed ardently for them and thanked God that through her kidnapping, He had brought her into the Catholic faith.

SISTER FERNANDA RIVA

Canossian Daughter of Charity

Sister Fernanda was born in Monza (Italy) on 17th April, 1920. She entered the Institute of the Canossian Daughters of Charity in Vimercate on 19th March, 1939 and was sent to India in October. She pronounced her Vows of Poverty, Chastity and Obedience on 24th December, 1941. She succeeded brilliantly in her studies and completed M.Ed. She was appointed Headmistress of Canossa High School, Mahim, and then Principal of the newly established College at Alleppey, Kerala.

Sr. Fernanda was outstanding in her love for people and her unassuming ways. Her spirituality was rooted in a deep love for Jesus Crucified and His Sorrowful Mother. All those who met her were struck by the radiance of her pure eyes and sweet smile. She had a preferential love for the poor and dexterously hid the good she did. She died of cancer on 22nd January, 1956 and was buried in St. Michael's Church cemetery, Mahim, Mumbai. On 13th October, 2016, her relics were taken to St. Joseph's Convent, Alleppey, Kerala.

PROSPECTUS

(Under the Direction of the Daughters
of Charity of Canossa)

Canossa Convent School recognised as a High School situated at Mahakali Caves Road, Andheri (East), Mumbai - 400 093, started as a primary school in 1968. It was upgraded in 1972.

Canossa High School is a Catholic School for Girls, established and administered by the Canossian Daughters of Charity.

The School is under the religious jurisdiction of the Archbishop of Mumbai.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

Preference in Admission to the School will be given to Catholic children. Admission, however, is open to children of other communities without distinction of caste or creed.

The goals and objectives of this school are expressions of St. Magdalene's Vision of Education. She says, "The school is the harvest that costs most, but which yields more fruit, for the conduct of one's whole life depends on the education one has received."

The special aim of the Daughters of Charity of Canossa is to prepare young girls entrusted to their care, for life, family and the nation with due emphasis on the formation of the PERSON by an integrated approach of Moral, Intellectual, Physical and Social formation of the individual child, irrespective of religion, race, caste, community, language and social status.

The course of instruction includes all the subjects required by the Government for the standard of English-teaching Schools in Maharashtra State. The school is subject to inspection by the Department of Education of the Maharashtra State Government. It is a High School and prepares pupils for the S.S.C. Board Examination.

To prepare our pupils for life we offer them: Spiritual and Moral training through religious and moral instruction.

With a view to preserving our Catholic faith, classes in religion are conducted and it is obligatory for Catholic students to attend these classes. Students of other faiths are taught Moral Science - a course in their fundamental duties to God, to their fellow beings, and to self.

The School stands for academic excellence, development of skills and character formation based on the love of God and the service of people as modelled on the Catholic faith.

Intellectual training is imparted through instruction aiming at academic excellence, helping students to think for themselves and arrive at a right judgement.

Physical Education is promoted with the purpose of developing a sound and healthy body. Programmes offered are Physical Training, Apparatus Drill and Yoga.

Emotional and Social training is encouraged through class democracy, leadership and team work, working for the poor through Social Service classes and the house system.

Cultural training is fostered through Co-curricular activities like Drama, Dancing, Elocution etc.

We aim at training our pupils to be simple, honest, kind cheerful at home and in any place, ready to be of service to the needy and the downtrodden, proud of their country and ready to be open to change.

REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES

1. The School year is divided into two Semesters beginning in **June** and **November** respectively.
2. Parents and Guardians are earnestly asked to adhere to school rules and co-operate with the school authorities.
3. Five minutes before the beginning of each session, at the first warning bell, all must move towards the Assembly Ground and at the next bell they should assemble according to their classes for the Assembly Prayers. At the second bell, the Assembly prayers begin, after which they walk in silence to their class-rooms, led by their teachers. The pupils may not go to the class, if the teacher is not present.
4. The students may not enter a class-room before the beginning of each session without the express permission of the teacher. At the end of each period, the students should silently wait for their next teacher.
5. When the attendance roll is called, each pupil must rise and answer to her name. Similarly, when a Superior enters the class, they should stand.
6. No pupil is allowed to leave the class-room without the teacher's permission or until the class is dismissed.
7. No pupil is permitted to have any social media page (facebook, instagram or snapchat account).
8. No pupil is allowed to wear fancy bracelet or earrings to school.
9. In the absence of the teacher, the class leader will be responsible for the order and discipline of the class.
10. When students move along the corridors, as when changing classes, they must walk in silence and in a single file. At the end of the session, the teacher should be the last to leave the class.

11. Mobiles, I-pods, books, magazines, photographs and play things are not allowed to be brought to School.
12. Catholic pupils should go for Confession often and for Holy Mass and Communion frequently. They should say their morning and evening prayers, the Rosary and make their examination of conscience every evening.
13. Irregular attendance, habitual inattention, misbehaviour, insubordination to teachers, any kind of cheating or serious misconduct, in school or even outside the school premises are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a pupil.
14. All the girls must be clean and tidy in their person, dress and manners. The wearing of white socks and the school uniform is a must even on examination days. They should always keep their books clean, neatly covered with their names written on them. Scribbling on books, desks, walls etc. is absolutely forbidden. It shows want of good breeding and is highly detrimental to the tone of the School.
15. Any damage done in the School premises must be made good.
16. Books should be provided within three days from the opening of the School. No books will be given on credit.
17. During recess, no pupil is to remain in any of the classrooms.
18. Pupils are absolutely forbidden to leave the School premises without the express permission of the Headmistress.
19. Pupils are forbidden to give their teachers individual or collective presents. On the occasion of their birthday, pupils are forbidden to distribute sweets in the class.
20. The School does not accept the responsibility for the loss of books, money, etc. Wearing of gold ornaments or any other valuables is strictly forbidden. and the school is not responsible.

FEES

21. New pupils as well as primary section students going to the secondary school must pay their fees at the time of Admission.
22. Parents and guardians unable to pay the fees on the Specified days will, on the same day, write to the Headmistress, stating when they will settle the account.
23. Fees must also be paid for all the months, during which the pupil's name has been retained on the register even if the pupil has been absent during the month.
24. No pupil will be allowed to sit for any examination unless the fees are fully paid.
25. Notice of withdrawal from school should be given in writing before the 15th of the month, else the fees for the following month will be charged. Such a notice should be given by the person responsible for the pupil, not by the pupil herself.
26. Applications for concession in fees by poor and needy students, have to be made in writing, within the first fortnight after the commencement of the School in June.
27. Full fees will be charged from those who enjoy concession, if not paid during the month on which they are due.
28. No application will be considered, if the pupil has shown unsatisfactory record in conduct, progress or attendance.
29. Every pupil ought to devote (to private study), about two hours in the evening and one hour in the morning on school days and more time on holidays according to the standard in which she is studying.

- सभी विद्यार्थी सुबह ७: २५ बजे तक प्रार्थना स्थल पर पहुँच जाएँ।
- विद्यार्थी निर्धारित स्कूल यूनिफॉर्म में आएँ, अच्छा व्यवहार रखें तथा विद्यालय के नियमों के अनुसार अपने बालों को अच्छी तरह और सलीके से बाँधकर रखें। स्कूल युनिफॉर्म के साथ सफेद पेटीकोट और नीली टाइट्स पहनना अनिवार्य है।
- नेल पॉलिश, मेहंदी या किसी भी प्रकार का डिज़ाइन लगाना मना है।
- मोबाइल फोन, आई-पॉड या कोई भी इलेक्ट्रॉनिक सामान तथा स्कूल से संबंधित न होने वाली चीज़ें लाना मना है।
- कक्षा में, गलियारे में और सीढ़ियों पर चलते समय शांति बनाए रखें।
- स्कूल की संपत्ति को नुकसान पहुँचाना (जैसे डेस्क, दीवार या वॉशरूम की दीवार पर लिखना) सख्त मना है।
- विद्यार्थी बिना उचित कारण के अनुपस्थित न हों।
- रोज़ की उपस्थिति की जानकारी शिक्षा विभाग को भेजी जाएगी।
- दो या दो से अधिक दिन की छुट्टी के लिए माता-पिता द्वारा लिखा और हस्ताक्षर किया हुआ प्रार्थना - पत्र देना होगा।
- छुट्टी केवल बीमारी या आवश्यक कार्य होने पर ही दी जाएगी। छुट्टी का पत्र माता-पिता हिंदी या अंग्रेज़ी में लिखकर हस्ताक्षर करें।
- किसी भी विद्यार्थी को Facebook, Instagram या Sanpchat पर अकाउंट बनाना या चलाना मना है।
- यदि आप चाहें तो में इसे अंतिम प्रिंट योग्य (Print-ready) प्रारूप में भी व्यवस्थित कर सकता/सकती हूँ।

ATTENDANCE

- New pupils as well as primary section students going to the secondary school must pay their fees at the time of Admission.
- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each session. Students absent without valid reason will be marked absent. Late-comers must submit a signed note from parents or guardians.
- Attendance will be sent on a daily basis to the department.
- The pupil should submit a signed leave application by the parent or guardian for absenteeism for two days or more.
- Leave of absence will be granted only in cases of illness or urgent necessity, with prior permission from parents/guardians.
- As per Board Regulations No.41 (1) (a), every student must maintain **75% attendance**. Students absent for one month without informing the school may have their names removed from the register.

N.B. Absence without leave is considered a serious breach of discipline.

- Leave notes must be written and signed by parents in English or Vernacular.
- Students must attend school on the reopening day after each vacation. Absence without leave may result in fine or removal of name from the roll.
- Participation in co-curricular activities organized by the school is compulsory.
- Sale of any items within the school premises is strictly prohibited.

EXAMINATIONS

- 1 a. For Std. IX, there will be two Semester Examinations during the year. The marks of the Semester examinations and unit tests will be taken into consideration for the results of the final examination.
- 1 b. For Stds. V-VIII, there will be Two Semester Examinations during the year. The marks of the Final Examination will be taken into consideration for the Results.
2. Absence in one or more subjects involves the loss of marks for these subjects, and excludes the pupils from being reckoned in the order of merit or rank in the examination.
3. Wilful breach of any of the regulations for the conduct of the examination, is punishable with expulsion from the examination room if discovered, subsequently, with the cancellation of the paper.
4. The results of the examinations are final and cannot be re-considered. Answer papers will not be shown. Parents and students should not contact the school office regarding this matter.

TO THE PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OF THE PUPILS

According to the revised Educational Code, the parents or guardians of the pupils are to be informed of the following rules of discipline :

1. That the parents have no right to dictate to the Management, but that the Management of the School has a right to say on what conditions they will admit or retain a pupil in their school.
2. That the parents should know the **School Rules** about admission, examinations and promotions and the payment of fees - date of payment and rate (all the necessary rules are given in the School Calendar).
3. Strict regularity and implicit obedience in the class is demanded from the pupils.
4. Any reported or observed objectionable conduct in the pupils, even out of the School, will be punished.
5.
 - (a) The pattern, colour and material of the school uniform should be as prescribed. The school uniform should be knee length. Students should daily wear blue bloomers compulsorily as part of their uniform.
 - (b) Students are not allowed to come to school with Mehendi, Nail Polish & long nails.
 - (c) Ankle length socks will not be allowed. Socks should be 6 inches above the ankle.
6. **Politeness, courtesy in speech and conduct as well as cleanliness in dress and person is expected from every pupil.**
7. No child suffering from any contagious or infectious disease or who is dirty, either in dress or person, will be permitted to attend School.

8. Leave of absence may be granted for a reasonable cause, but only on application from the parent or guardian. This request must be made in advance, whenever possible.
9. Parents and guardians should examine the Calendar and the different reports and use them to control and direct the children in their studies at home.
10. Parents and Guardians are not allowed to see their children or interview the teachers during School hours unless required by the teacher or with prior permission.
11. The School does not guarantee the success of a student's studies. It is the duty of the parents or guardians to co-operate with the School authority and do their part by enforcing regularity and discipline. They must see that their children do their home work and prepare their lessons daily. Let them specially insist on punctuality and regularity in attending class.
12. Children will not be sent home during School hours, unless parents or a responsible person comes to take them.

HOW TO USE THE CALENDAR

1. Use the diary to help you to do your daily School duties as follows :

Before coming to School, always have at least a week's subjects written one below the other. As soon as the teacher gives work, write it against the subject on the proper days. Do, on a holiday, all the lessons that you sometimes might not have done.

2. **The Calendar must be brought to School every day and followed in detail. Daily lessons, reports and home-work should be taken down. Parents should regularly see their child's calendar and notes and sign the child's report.**

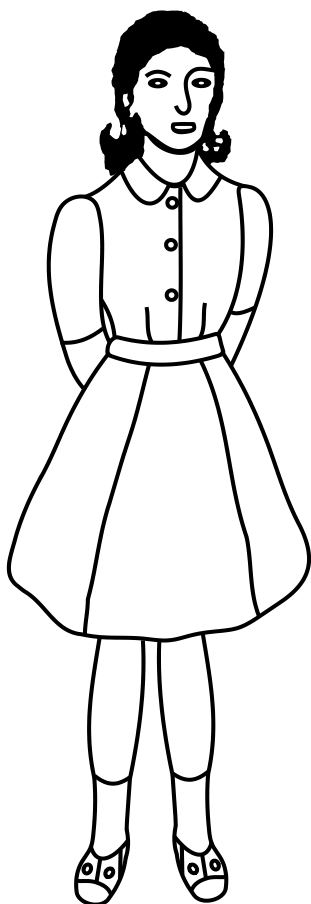

THE SCHOOL UNIFORM

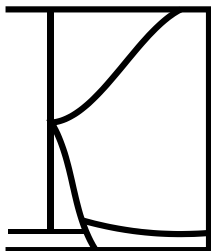


The School uniform must be of the right colour and material, stitched according to the pattern with a white collar and white buttons and should reach the knee.

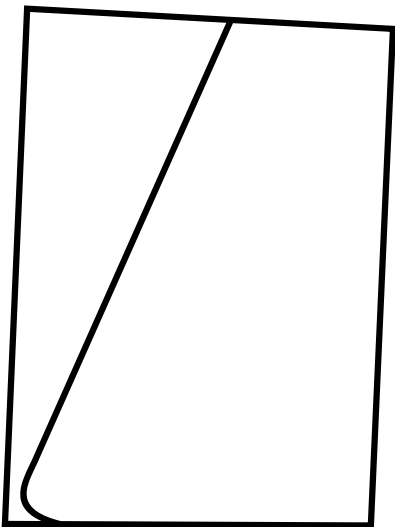
The sleeves must be one inch above the elbow. The students must wear black shoes and socks and white hair bands or white ribbons if necessary.

A Draft for the Canossa School Uniform Pattern

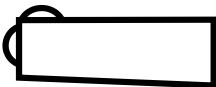
